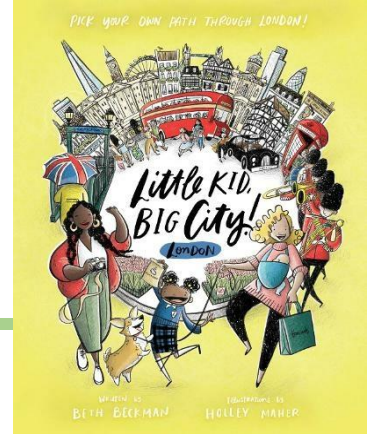
Children at after school club have the opportunity to take part in challenges, sport, play, art and craft.
