In Year 1, we will begin learning how to form letters using a precursive style.


#### **Spelling**

We will continue to learn phonics using Little Wandle Letters and Sounds. We will also learn the statutory common exception words for Year 1 taught as 'tricky words'.

#### Content to be taught and applied in writing this year

Word	<ul> <li>Regular plural noun suffixes –s or –es (e.g. dog, dogs; wish, wishes) including the effects of these suffixes on the meaning of the noun</li> <li>Suffixes that can be added to verbs where no change is needed in the spelling of root words (e.g. helping, helped, helper)</li> <li>How the prefix un- changes the meaning of verbs and adjectives (e.g. untie, unkind)</li> <li>Adjectives are used to describe nouns</li> </ul>
Sentence	<ul> <li>Orally compose a sentence</li> <li>How words can combine to make sentences</li> <li>Joining words and joining clauses using and</li> </ul>
Text	Sequencing sentences to form short narratives or non-narrative writes
Punctuation	<ul> <li>Separation of words with spaces</li> <li>Use of capital letters, full stops, question marks and exclamation marks to demarcate sentences</li> <li>Use of capital letters for names and the personal pronoun I</li> </ul>
Terminology	<ul> <li>letter, capital letter</li> <li>noun, adjective, singular, plural</li> <li>sentence</li> <li>punctuation, full stop, question mark, exclamation mark</li> </ul>
