What will we be writing in our English Lessons?

We will learn to write for a variety of audiences through different narrative and non- narrative genres.

Cross- curricular writing

We will be using the writing skills, that we learn in our English lessons, across all other subject areas.

Handwriting

In Year 4, we will continue to learn how to join letters using a cursive style.

Spelling

We will learn to spell using a sounds and written symbols approach as well as using morphology to spell through meaning. Year 4 will also learn to read and write the LKS2 Statutory Spellings.

Content to be taught and applied in writing this year The grammatical difference between plural and possessive –s Standard English forms for verb inflections instead of local spoken forms (e.g. we were instead of we was)
