Fruit and drinks

At 10.00 we have our milk and a piece of fruit. During this time, we look at Tapestry, your online learning journal, to see what fun activities you have been doing at home. You can bring in your own fruit if you would prefer.

Dinner

At 11.30 you can eat your dinner. You can either have a hot school dinner or a packed lunch in the hall. All school dinners are free in Reception and you can have them every day. Have a look at what our menu looks like with your family and maybe you could start to choose what your favourites might be.

Whichever you choose, you need to go to the toilet and wash your hands before you eat. After lunch you will play with your friends in the playground until 12.45 and then the afternoon activities will begin.

Reading

We share lots of stories in school and you will have books to take home to read. Some of them you will read for yourself, others are for grownups to read with you. You will also have an e-book to read each week on Collins e-books.

You will need to have a book bag to take your books home in. You will bring it to school every day. These can be purchased in school.



We expect you to share your books at home every day, talking about the pictures, reading some of the words and looking for sounds you know.

School Uniform

When you come to school you need to wear:



You will need white, grey or black socks. You can wear white, grey or black tights. As the weather gets warmer in the summer term, you can wear grey or black shorts or a blue and white check dress. Your parents can get the school jumpers from our school website in the parent section.

All of your clothes and shoes will need to have your name in as all your friends will have the same clothes on and you may get them mixed up. You might wish to bring wellington boots to school too, so that we can have fun splashing in puddles and trudging through mud!

PE

We do a lot of different activities in school. Each week we all do PE. For this you will need:

Shorts or tracksuit bottoms



A t-shirt



Plimsolls



You will need to keep all of these in a PE bag on your peg.

You need to ask your carer to make sure that your name is in all of your clothes. You are not allowed to wear any jewellery for PE, but if it can't be removed, you will need to tape them up before arriving at school.
